Vaccinations will be administered by the Veterinary team of the Henniker Veterinary Hospital, under the direction of Dr. Robert Brust, Veterinarian and Rotary member, and Dr. Alyssa Brust. The cost for the Clinic is \$12.00 each for the first two pets, \$6.00 for each additional pet. If your dog has been vaccinated previously, bring your Rabies certificate with you to qualify for a three-year vaccination.

Please bring all dogs on leashes, all cats in covered carriers. Free gifts will be distributed to cats and dogs registering for the Rabies Clinic. The Mutt Hut will again provide nail clipping services for a modest donation with proceeds going to the Rotary Club. There
